From 2022 Associate Professor in Plant Pathology at the University of Pisa. Author of almost 70 papers on indexed journals, of more than 100 contributions to National and International Conferences and of book chapters, all concerning plant pathology, biocontrol and fungal ecology. Associate Editor of several International Journals in the field of Plant Pathology and Senior Editor of *Phytopathology*. Member of the Directive Board of the Italian Phytopathological Society (SIPaV) and Aggregated Academic of the “Accademia dei Georgofili” (Florence, Italy).

She mainly works on the biology, ecology and secondary metabolism of beneficial fungi belonging to *Trichoderma* genus, on the use of biocontrol agents and sustainable tools for the control of mycotoxigenic fungi.
